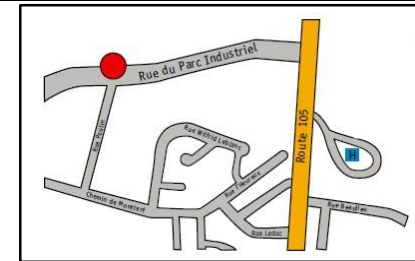
Pricing for materials <u>Minimum 6 \$ per visit</u>	
<b>Concrete</b>	<b>50 \$ / ton</b>
Reinforced or not	
<b>"Natural" Wood and branches</b>	<b>65 \$ / ton</b>
Such as: timber, plywood, particle board, branches	
<b>Roofing shingles</b>	<b>125 \$ / ton</b>
Separate from other construction materials	
<b>Construction materials</b>	<b>190 \$ / ton</b>
Such as: gyproc, vinyl siding, pressure treated wood, painted or stained wood	
<b>Garbage (MONDAY TO THURSDAY ONLY)</b>	<b>210 \$ / ton</b>
Such as: Household waste, large items (furniture etc.), all other type of material mixed with garbage	
<b>Oversized tires, damaged tires or tires with rims</b>	<b>0.30 \$ / kg</b>
Greater than 123,19 cm (48,5") in diameter	
Greater than 335 cm (132") in diameter	<b>0.30 \$ / kg</b>
<b>Very big garbage</b>	<b>210 \$ / ton + 100 \$ additional fee</b>
Such as: boat, trailer, big concrete slab	
<b>Public weighing</b>	<b>20 \$</b>

Materials accepted free of charge	
<b>Recyclable Materials</b>	<b>Free</b>
Paper, plastic, cardboard, glass, plastic and metal usually accepted in curbside recycling pick-up	
<b>Metal</b>	<b>Free</b>
Such as: Ferrous and non-ferrous metal, home appliances.	
<b>Hazardous Household Waste</b>	<b>Free</b>
Such as: - Paint; - Oil oil filters and used oil containers; - Aerosols and lubricants; - used batteries; - compact fluorescent lightbulbs, neon tubes - all other organic or inorganic household hazardous waste;	
<b>Electronics</b>	<b>Free</b>
Domestic electronics such as: Office computers, laptops, notebooks, e-book readers, cell phones, televisions, printers scanners, photocopiers, fax machines, keyboards, mouse, cables, remotes, etc. Excludes commercial floor-fixed equipment	
<b>Yard Waste</b>	<b>Free</b>
Leaves and grass cuttings (no plastic bags)	<b>Free</b>
<b>Tires without rims (including damaged tires)</b>	<b>Free</b>
Car and truck tires < 123,19 cm (48,5")	<b>Free</b>
<b>Propanes cylinders</b>	<b>Free</b>
